

# DOCNA CHAMPIONSHIPS

## Standard and Jumpers scoring made SIMPLE

Standard Agility Round 1, Standard Agility Round 2, and Standard Agility Final Round and Jumpers Round 1, Jumpers 2, and Jumpers Final Round at the DOCNA Championships will be scored using the method of time plus faults. This means that the "SCORE" in each of the rounds will be the dog's time added together with any course faults. Placements will be calculated based on the lowest scores. All calculations are done automatically in the Agility Unscrambled software, but in the event of a question or issue, this document should help explain it. In the event of a tie in the Total Faults column, the tie is broken by the lowest time. In the event of a true tie where both time AND faults are a tie, and there is a placement award at stake, there should be a runoff. The run off rules will be described at the end.

There are individual placement awards for both Round 1 and Round 2. After the completion of Rounds 1 and 2, scores are combined to determine the top 25% of the scores and those who will be moving on to run in the Final Round. Please see the example Advancement Report below that shows which dogs move on to the final round. Dogs must have been entered in both rounds to be eligible to move on. Scratches and eliminations are awarded a high score of 200 for that round when scores are calculated. The Eligible and Entered categories are of use only to the programmers and score table as a check and balance that software is working correctly. For competitor purposes, if there is a YES in both columns, they will move on to the final. If there is a YES in only one column, there is a special situation and they should check with the score table.

There will be no scribe sheets printed for scoring the final run. After the Advancements report is run, the score table will print out a run order with scoring space that will be used to scribe the final round.

After the Final round is runs, all 3 scores from Round1, Round2, and the Final are totaled and the lowest score is the Overall winner for the class. The results are reported on the Final Round – Final Report. There will be up to 3 placements awards in each jump height in each division. There are no individual placement awards for the Final round, only the cumulative one.

### **Round 1 and Round 2 Tie Breaker**

Regarding placement, in the event of a tie in the Total Faults column for individual Rounds 1 and 2, the tie is broken by the lowest time. In the event of a true tie where both time AND faults are a tie, there will be a runoff to break the tie for the sole purpose of awarding any placement ribbons. The original times will stay recorded for purposes of advancement. The score table must make the scores available to the judge ASAP after the end of each run in order to determine if this is an issue. If the course where the tie occurred has already been changed, another standard or jumpers course, respectively, can be used, regardless of level, and the runoff may be delayed until the following day. The judge will make the final decision.

### **Final Round Tie Breaker**

***There are no individual placement awards for the final round, so no tie breaker will be necessary.***

### **Standard/Jumpers Champion Tie Breaker**

The Standard/Jumpers Champion is determined by combining the scores from Round 1, Round 2, and the Final Round. If the total score is a tie, then score from Final Round will be used to break the tie. If the Final Round score is a tie as well, then the tie is broken by the lowest time. In the event of a true tie at the end of the Final Round, (where after all tie breakers, there is still a tie), there will be a runoff on the final course to determine placement. The score table must make the scores available to the judge ASAP after the end of each final round in order to determine if this is an issue as a new course cannot be built until it is determined that no runoffs are needed.
